BUILDING

3 new classrooms have been built for the students to move in this year. A new library and community center are now open to the students and the community

STUDENTS

This year the school enrolled 120 children between Preschool 1, Preschool 2, First grade, Second grade, third grade and 4th grade.

NUTRITION

Thanks to the support of Catholic Relief Services (CRS), we continue to offer a meal a day to the children.

PROGRESS/ACCOMPLISHMENT

- We completed the year with 120 students.
- Ecole du Village welcomes the International Christian School <http://www.kbics.com> as a new partner. Mrs. Ines Lozano, principal of the school visited Ecole du Village and organized a day of fun activities with the students. International Christian School <http://www.kbics.com> also raised \$9000 during the year to help in the construction of 2 classrooms.
- Ecole du Village also wants to thank Parris Keane who raised over \$3000 for the construction of another classroom.
- Ecole du Village continues to partner with St. Bridget Elementary School in Framingham. www.saintbridgetschool.info and has started a pen pal programs with first grade students at St. Bridget.
- EDEM Foundation opened a new Library/Community Center with over 200 children books and over 100 books for parents and community leaders. The new community center is a venue for children to improve their reading skills and learn about new subjects. The center is located next to the school.
- CRS continues to provide a daily meal to the children.
- The students will be entering into 3 brand new classrooms this year.
- The school welcome students from the Massachusetts Maritime Academy who spent a week teaching the kids about renewable energy and working with the teachers on an ongoing emergency response plan for any possible
- With support from the Gaskov Clerge Foundation <http://www.gaskov.org/> and Zafen www.zafen.org, a new water filtration system has been installed at the school and the water tank has been renovated to provide clean water to the students.

PLAN FOR 2011-2012

- Add one more grade (5th grade)
- build 2 new classrooms
- Send more volunteers to provide training to the teachers
- Continue partnership with International Christian School
- Continue partnership with St. Bridget School
- Make reading one book a month mandatory to every student
- Initiate a library day on Fridays
